Dear local resident,

As you will already be aware, our contractors are currently undertaking groyne replacement works in your area.

The works are advancing as planned, however there is a surplus of rock. This surplus rock will be temporarily stored adjacent to the most northerly offshore reef at Eccles. We plan to use this rock in future groyne replacement works between Eccles and Winterton. Due to the expiration of the current MMO license, constructing any further new groynes in the area using the excess rock is not possible at this time.

We continue to greatly appreciate your patience and understanding. The groynes along this frontage help to retain beach levels that protect the sea defence wall from erosion. This is essential to protect both people and property in the area.
